



**Join in the fun with “Say & Do®” Verbs Bingo!
2-6 Players • All Ages!**

Contents:

- 60 bingo playing surfaces (30 bingo boards printed front and back).
- 48 regular verbs and 48 irregular verbs are presented in the present tense and the past tense.
- 240 verb cards with storage bags.
- Bingo chips (assorted colors).

Object of the game:

Be the first player to get five chips in a row whether across, down, or diagonally.

Getting ready to play:

Separate all of the verb cards. Sort them by board number and place them in individual storage bags.

How to play:

1. Decide which verbs to practice with your students. The boards are numbered: Regular Verbs (1 and 3), Regular Past Tense (2 and 4), Irregular Verbs (5 and 7), Irregular Past Tense (6 and 8) and Combo Past Tense (9 and 10).
2. Pass out boards and bingo chips. Players cover the free space with a chip.
3. The caller shuffles the verb cards that match the chosen board and puts them face down in a pile.
4. The caller draws one card from the pile, reads the card, and lets the players guess the answer. As a variation, the caller can just read the answer aloud and have the players make up a sentence using the verb correctly.
5. Each player locates the matching picture on his/her bingo board and covers it with a chip.
6. The first player to cover five pictures in a row across, down, or diagonally calls out “Verb Bingo!” This person is the winner.

Variations:

- Use verb cards without the boards to reinforce rhyming and other language skills.
- Have the students place their bingo boards on the floor. Students take turns tossing bingo chips onto target boards. Students say the past tense verb for each picture a token lands on.
